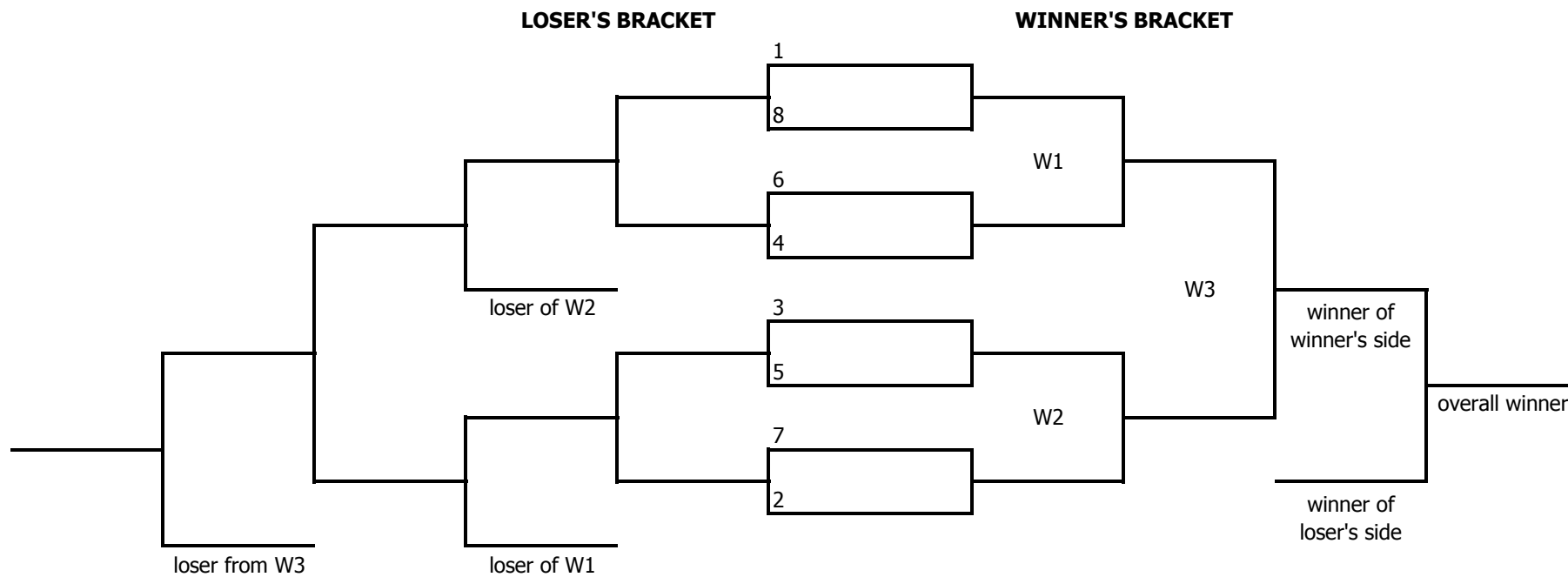


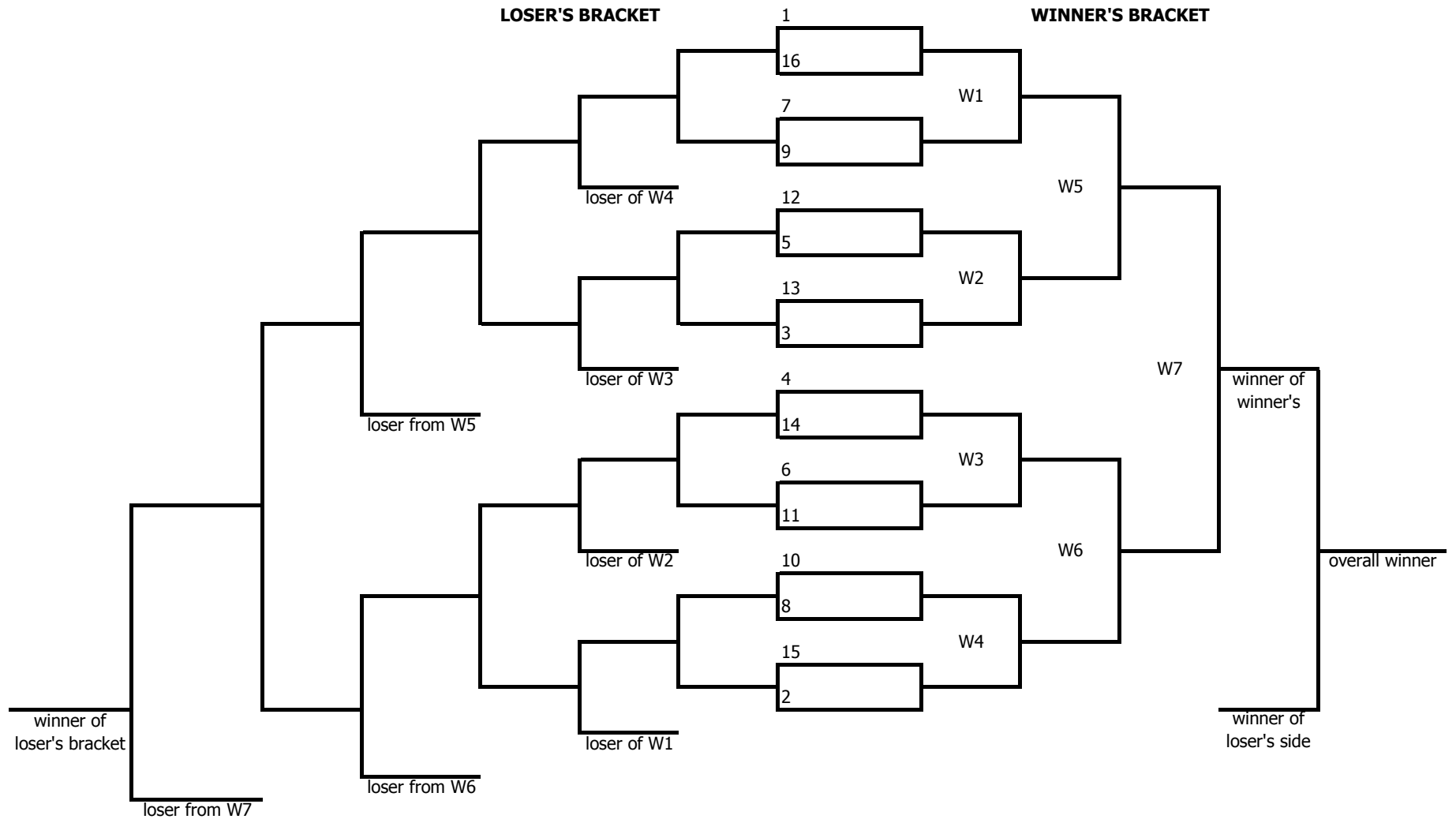
## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING THE POOL4U.COM BRACKET SHEETS:**

- 1)** Take numbered cards or "pea bottle" and keep the numbered cards or peas for the number of players you have in the tournament. For example, if you have 6 players, keep only 1-6. The brackets are set up to have any numbers higher than that in their appropriate "bye" position.
- 2)** Take numbered cards and place face down on a pool table or take a "pea bottle" and let the players choose their numbers. Alternatively, you can have one person draw the numbers.
- 3)** Write those numbers down next to the player's name on your players list. (I'm assuming you have one.) Then enter those names next to their corresponding number position on the bracket sheet.
- 4)** In the first matches of the bracket, insert winners' names to right, losers' to the left. Subsequently, insert winners to right, and losers from the winner's bracket into the indicated slots within the loser's bracket.
- 5)** The winner of the winner's bracket and the winner of the loser's bracket play for the championship. Since this is double elimination, the winner's bracket winner must only win one match to be the overall winner, the loser's bracket winner must win two matches.

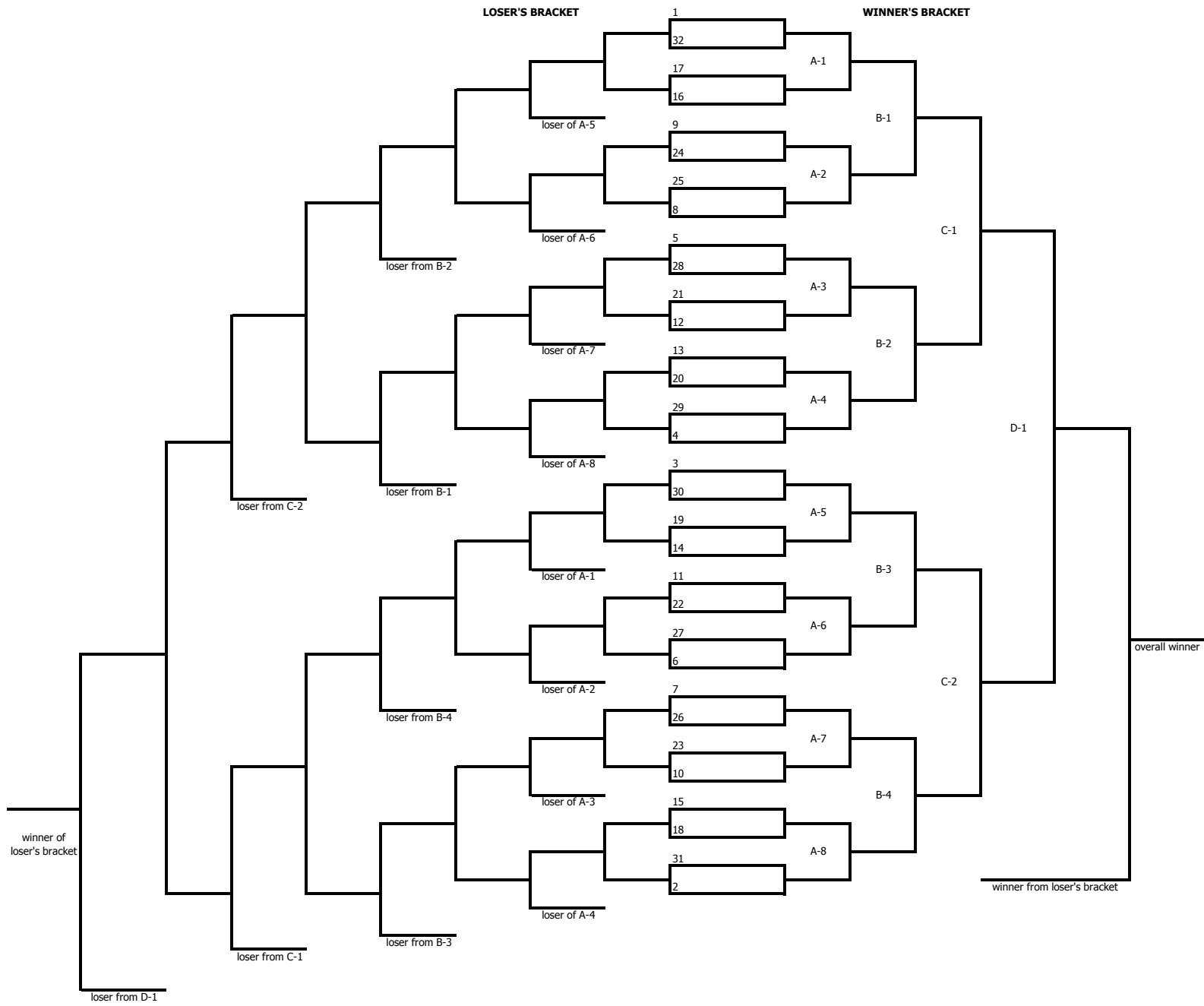
